past work may have video-tapes of any class session made where they work. Organizations agree to erase all such tapes at the close of each semester.

Organizations may also use video tapes of classroom sessions for their employee-students located in areas not reached by the live TV system. Such students are provided with classroom materials and are encouraged to talk once a week to instructors during prescribed office hours. They may earn academic credit and are charged tuition just as students within the TV reception area.

CHICAGO AREA NETWORK FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION

Organizations that participate in the IIT academic program through the instructional television network are also eligible to become part of the Chicago Area Network for Continuing Education, or CHANCE. This organization, established and operated by and directly responsive to the educational needs of net-



COST CONSIDERATIONS

Participating organizations are asked to make a three-year guarantee in advance at present tuition rates against educational services to be received. This guarantee is for a minimum of course registrations per year, determined by the number of employees eligible in the organization. Any portion of the tuition guarantee not used up by actual course registrations over the three-year period is credited against future use at no further cost to the organization.

Each member organization also makes an annual service commitment (again scaled to the number of eligible employees) to compensate IIT for providing and maintaining work members, provides continuing education of all kinds on the network when IIT classes are not in session. CHANCE is governed by a Board of Directors composed primarily of representatives of member organizations.

The CHANCE network offers the opportunity for members to make available to their employees professional development programs other than those obtained through formal degree-oriented courses. These are especially arranged by CHANCE for the participating organizations. A specified annual fee permits unlimited student participation as well as selection of courses to be placed on the network.
