Work moves ahead on IIT heat plant

Since the completion of the pilings on the site of the new heat plant at 35th and Federal streets, action is being taken to insure a solid foundation by excavation and drainage of the base of the building.

Excess piling extensions are being cut and wood legs are being constructed to block off the water-logged area. The Lake-State engineers are hammering in metal sheathing to safeguard the embankment that parallels the New York Central railroad tracks.

Oliver Jensen, superintendent in charge of construction, stated that all excavation problems "should be overcome within the next two or three weeks." At that time, bricklayers will arrive to begin erecting the main structure.

The foundation should be near completion by the time work begins on the chimney.

The central supporting wall for this 200-foot structure has been poured and is in the process of being set. The base of the supporting wall is 19 feet in diameter. A clean-out door will be about 20 feet above the street level.

The central heating plant is intended to supply hot water facilities to all the buildings in the projected area of Technology Center.
