



Technology Center's RESIDENCE AREA

A modern apartment with all the advantages of living close to work or class — that's what the Illinois Institute of Technology offers you through residence at Technology Center's newly-developed housing area on Chicago's near south side.

Four multi-story apartment buildings provide for the latest conveniences in apartment living within a few minutes' walk of the offices, laboratories, and classrooms at Technology Center.

There are 356 living units ranging from efficiency quarters to three-bedroom apartments. They are available to faculty, staff, and students on an annual lease basis, with the lease period ending August 31.

Three of the apartment buildings — Carman, Bailey, and Cunningham halls — were designed by Ludwig Mies van der Rohe, world famous architect and director of the department of architecture at Illinois Tech.

The residential area, centralized around a city block bounded by Michigan and Wabash avenues and 31st and 32nd streets, also includes a shopping center, chapel, park and playground, tennis courts, and parking lots.
