



## CARMAN HALL

60 E. 32nd Street

Carman Hall is a nine-story, reinforced concrete building having 96 apartments. It is named for George Noble Carman, first director of Lewis Institute, one of Illinois Tech's predecessor institutions.

On the main floor are a lobby, offices of the housing manager, and a game room with ceiling-to-floor windows on three sides. The basement provides a large laundry room and a workshop for residents.

### *All-electric kitchens—*

- 4 or 6 cubic foot refrigerator
- 4 - burner, oven - equipped electric stove
- Steel wall cabinets

### *Floors—*

- Cork in living area
- Asphalt tile in kitchen
- Ceramic tile in bath

Radiant heat by hot water, thermostatically controlled at each apartment. Window draperies are furnished.
