



BAILEY HALL

3101 S. Wabash Avenue

One of the two newest residence facilities at Technology Center is Bailey Hall, which has nine floors and 88 apartment units. It was constructed in 1954.

The hall is named in honor of Alex D. Bailey, chairman of the board of Lewis Institute from 1936 to 1940 and now vice-chairman of the Illinois Tech board of trustees. The main floor contains a lounge area and recreation room, while the basement has a laundry room and a workshop.
