HE Photographical Society of Armour Institute of Technology are at present located in their new rooms in the Mission building. The use of three rooms with electric and gas lighting is afforded its members. Two of these rooms are equipped as dark rooms; one for printing and enlarging, and the other for developing.

A set of fifty lockers, an enlarging camera, arc, incandescent, and ruby lights, together with other apparatus and equipment; such as trays, graduates, wash-boxes, chemicals, etc.; used in enlarging, and contact-printing, will be found in the first room.

In the second room are arc and incandescent lamps for copying and lantern slide work, and also a series of ruby lights and boxes, giving a wide range of ruby intensities.

The society is in a prosperous financial condition and hope soon to add at least one fan-motor for drying purposes, and a new enlarging lens.

Although they have been somewhat delayed in getting settled in their new quarters; the Society hopes to hold its fourth annual exhibit in the spring.
