

THE following plots show graphically the ups and downs of the team.

The solid line shows the scores of Armour, the dotted line those of the opponents, and the double line shows the algebraic sum of the scores, considering Armour's as positive and the opponents as negative. The upward trend of this last line shows the consistent improvement made by the team. Had the second game not been against opponents so much heavier than we were, we would surely have won the next two, as the teams we played then were in no way superior to the last three we played.

The scale for the single line curves is $\frac{1}{8}''=1$, and for the double line curve, $\frac{1}{20}''=1$.
