Any man in the college who holds actively a position as an executive head, that is, editor-in-chief, managing editor, business manager, or the equivalent of any of these on any recognized student publication, becomes entitled to membership in this organization. Further by unanimous vote of such entitled members, any man who has served for at least one year on any of the publications, but who has not held an executive position on the same, may be elected to membership, but the number of such elected men can never be in excess of half the number of entitled members.

Thus, in addition to its two functions stated above, The Sphinx becomes at once an honorary society, membership to which can only be had through merit of service on the different recognized student publications.
