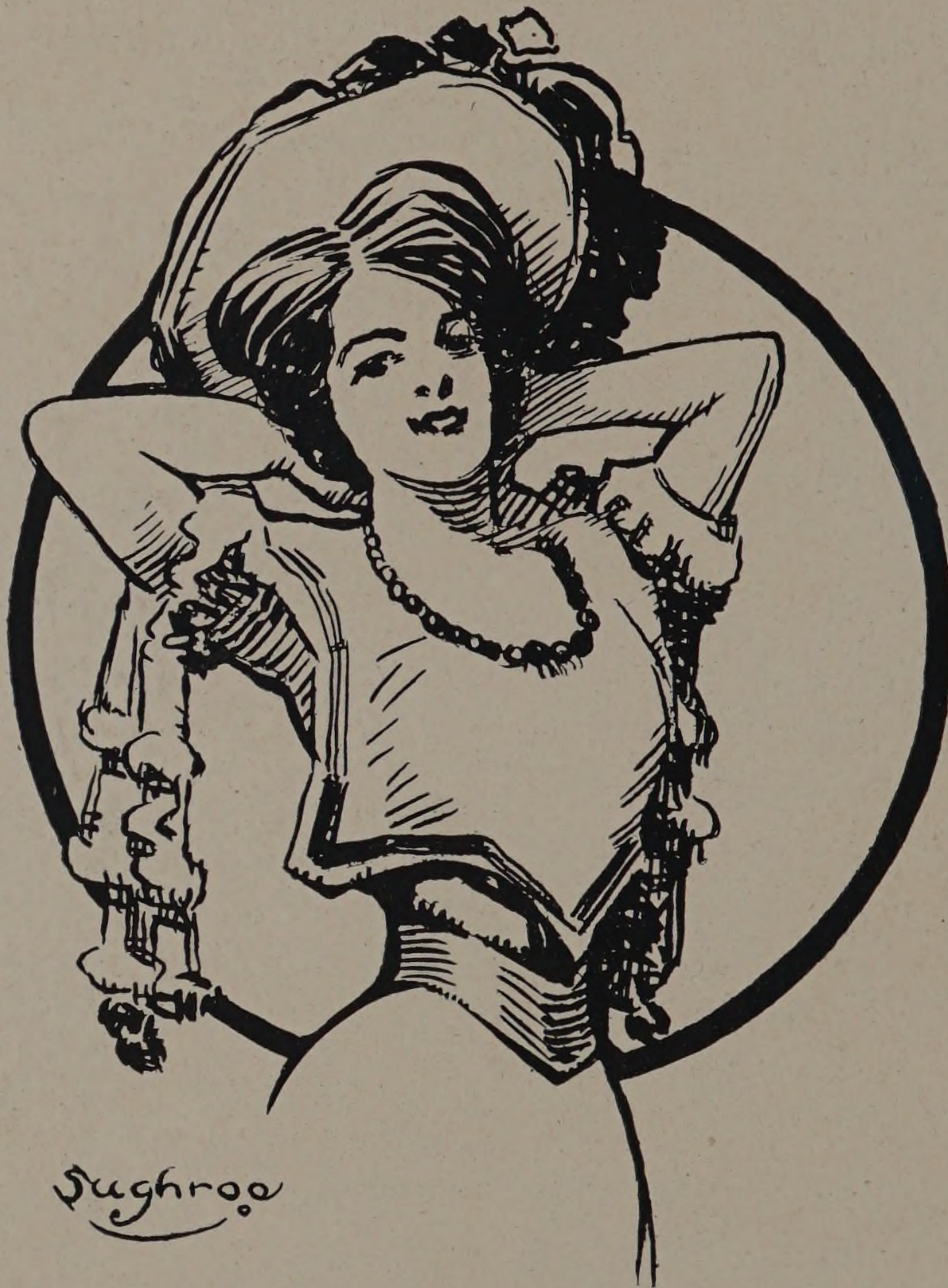


### HOW TIME DOES CHANGE
