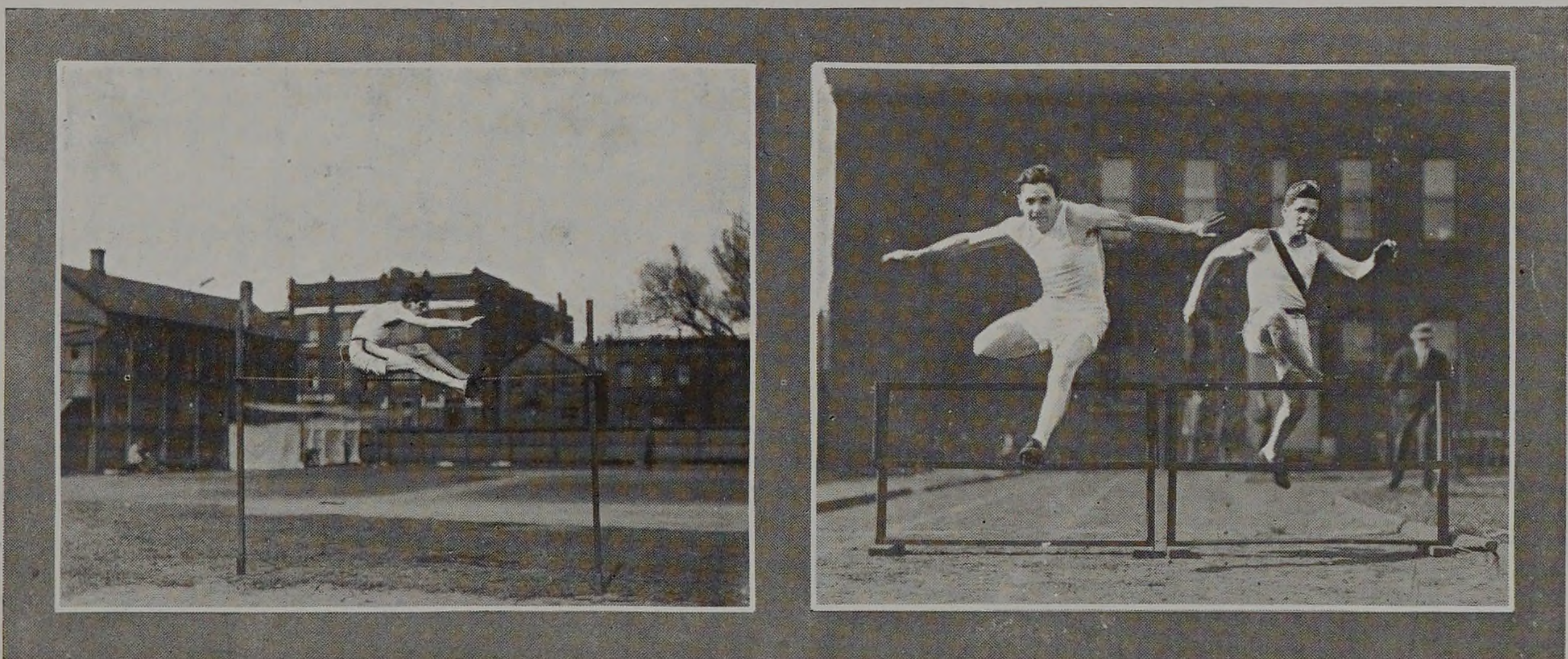


Review of the College Track Season
