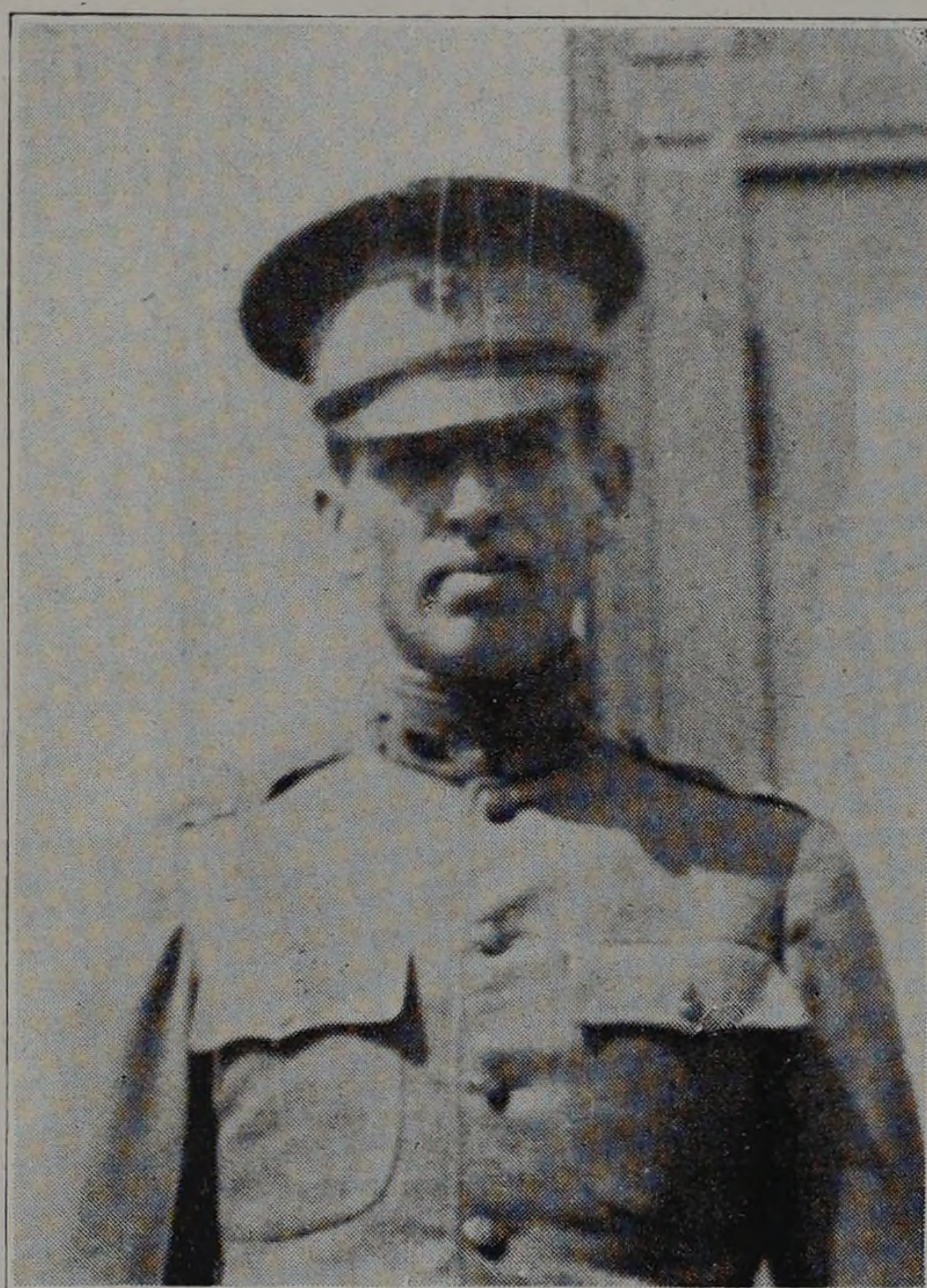




Captain Vincent E. Kannally was born in Oracle, Arizona, on June 9, 1885. Previous to his enlistment he was a cattle rancher at Oracle. On August 26, 1917, he entered the Second Officers' Training Camp at Fort Sheridan, Ill. He received his commission as Captain in the Infantry on November 27, 1917, and assigned to the 89th Division at Camp Funston, Kansas. Remaining here during the winter he was assigned as Commanding Officer, N.A. Training Detachment at Colorado Springs, on May 14, 1918. On September 14, 1918, he was sent to Armour Institute as Commanding Officer of the S. A. T. C. where he remained until his discharge from service, January 14, 1919.
