
Lieut. Ozro White Cunningham was born in Marshall County, Tenn., on June 25, 1871. He attended the Kentucky School of Medicine, Louisville, Ky., where he graduated with the class of 1902. He practiced his profession at Valley View, Texas.

In September, 1917, he was commissioned 1st Lieut. in the Medical Reserve Corps, and was called to active duty in February, 1918, when he was sent to Fort Sill, Okla., and assigned to the 9th Field Artillery. On March 30, he was transferred to Fort Riley, Kan. After completion of this course, he was assigned to duty with the S. A. T. C. at "Armour" where he remained until his discharge December 23, 1918.
