



The Armour Y. M. C. A. is one of the departments of the Illinois Y. M. C. A. The object of the Y. M. C. A. is to provide a place of recreation and study, and to raise the standard of morals of the student body. Any student may join, for the Association is not denominational. A membership in this department entitles the holder to the house privileges at any of the city departments, and those of other cities. The membership also gives the students reduced rates when joining any of the city departments.

The affairs of the department are controlled by a Board of Managers, composed of seven faculty and three student members. The fourth officer, the Executive Secretary, is appointed by the Board of Managers. The President, Recording Secretary and the Executive Secretary compose the three student members of the Board of Managers.

The Association occupies rooms on the third floor of Chapin Hall, 3321 Federal Street. These rooms are nicely furnished and decorated. They are for the use of student members desiring a place for study and recreation.
