The Armour Institute Y. M. C. A. is one of the departments of the Illinois Y. M. C. A. The Association occupies rooms on the third floor of Chapin Hall, 3321 Federal Street. One of the rooms contains a billiard table, which may be used by the members, and the other room is furnished for studying and reading purposes.

The department is governed by a Board of Managers, composed of seven faculty and two student members. The student members of the Board of Managers are the President and the Executive Secretary.

The object of the Y. M. C. A. is to provide a place of recreation and study, and to raise the standard of morals of the student body. Any student may join, as the Association is not denominational.
