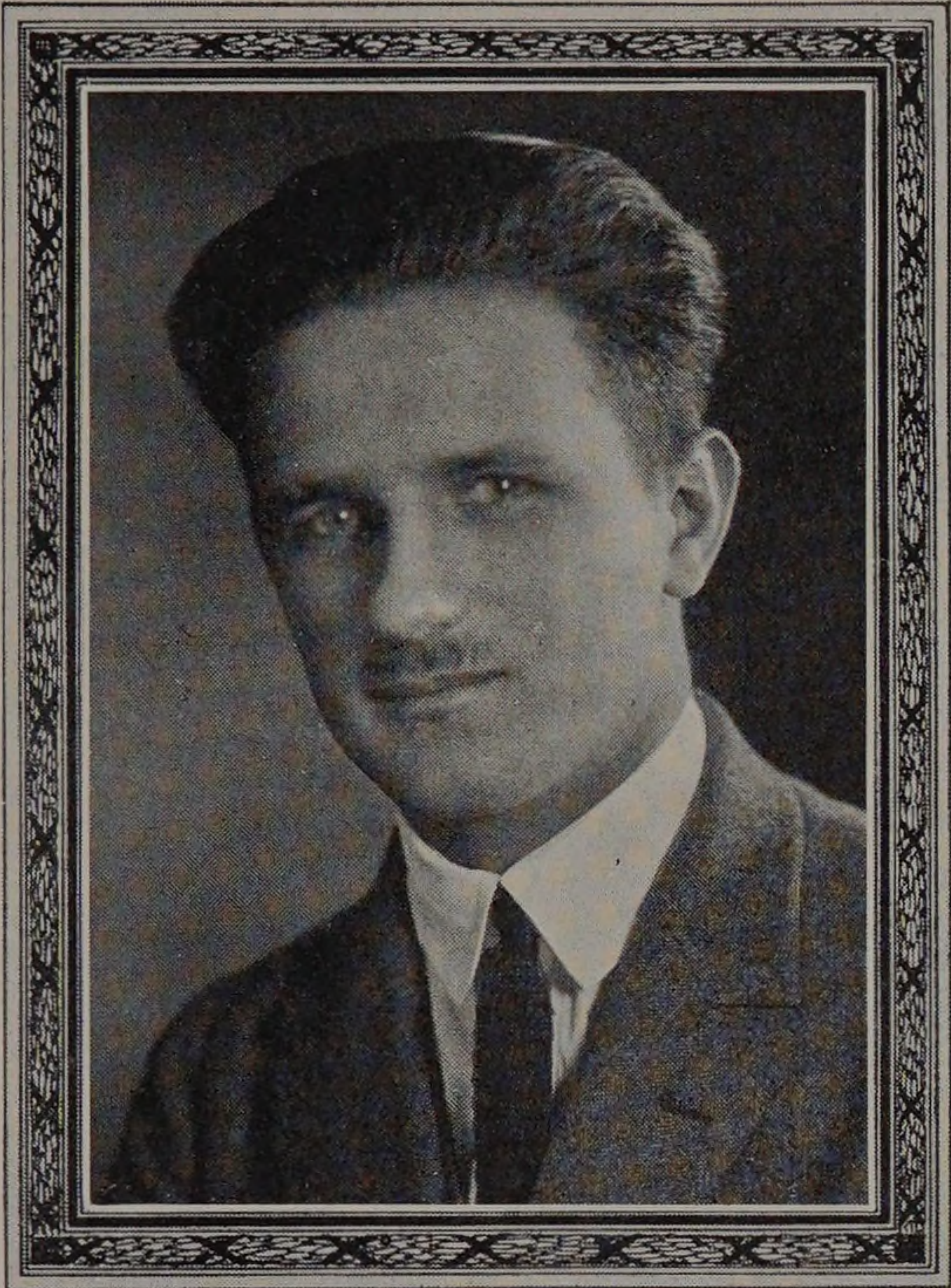


## CLASSES
