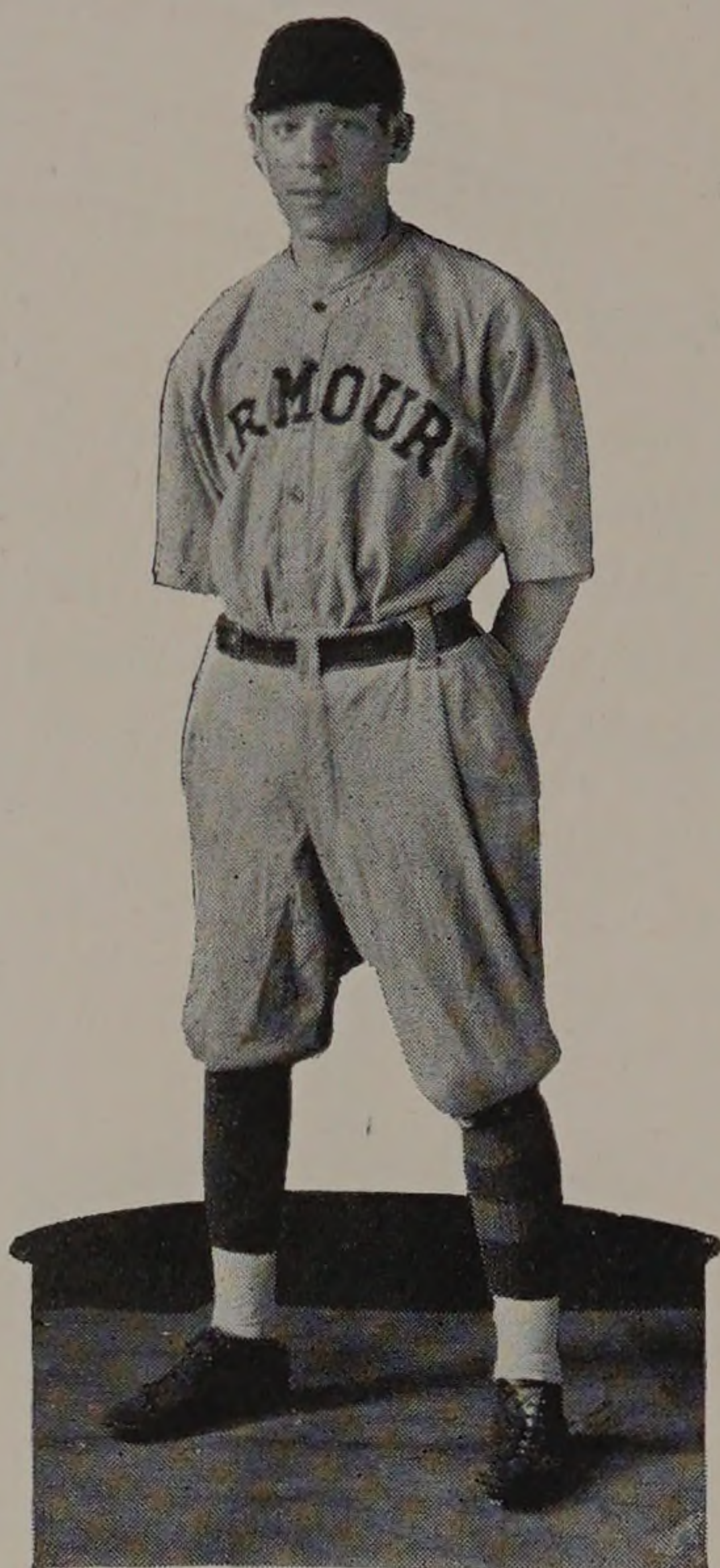
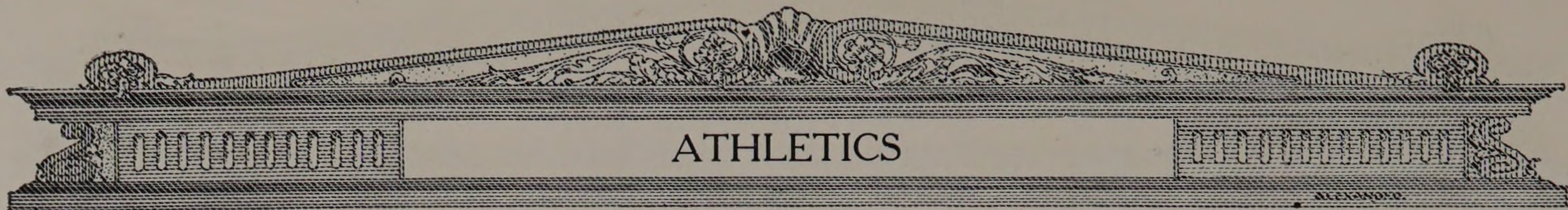




WITASKIS
