Professor Leigh, himself a choir-master and a lover of music, has had a guiding and steady hand upon the affairs of the Armour Tech Musical Clubs this year.

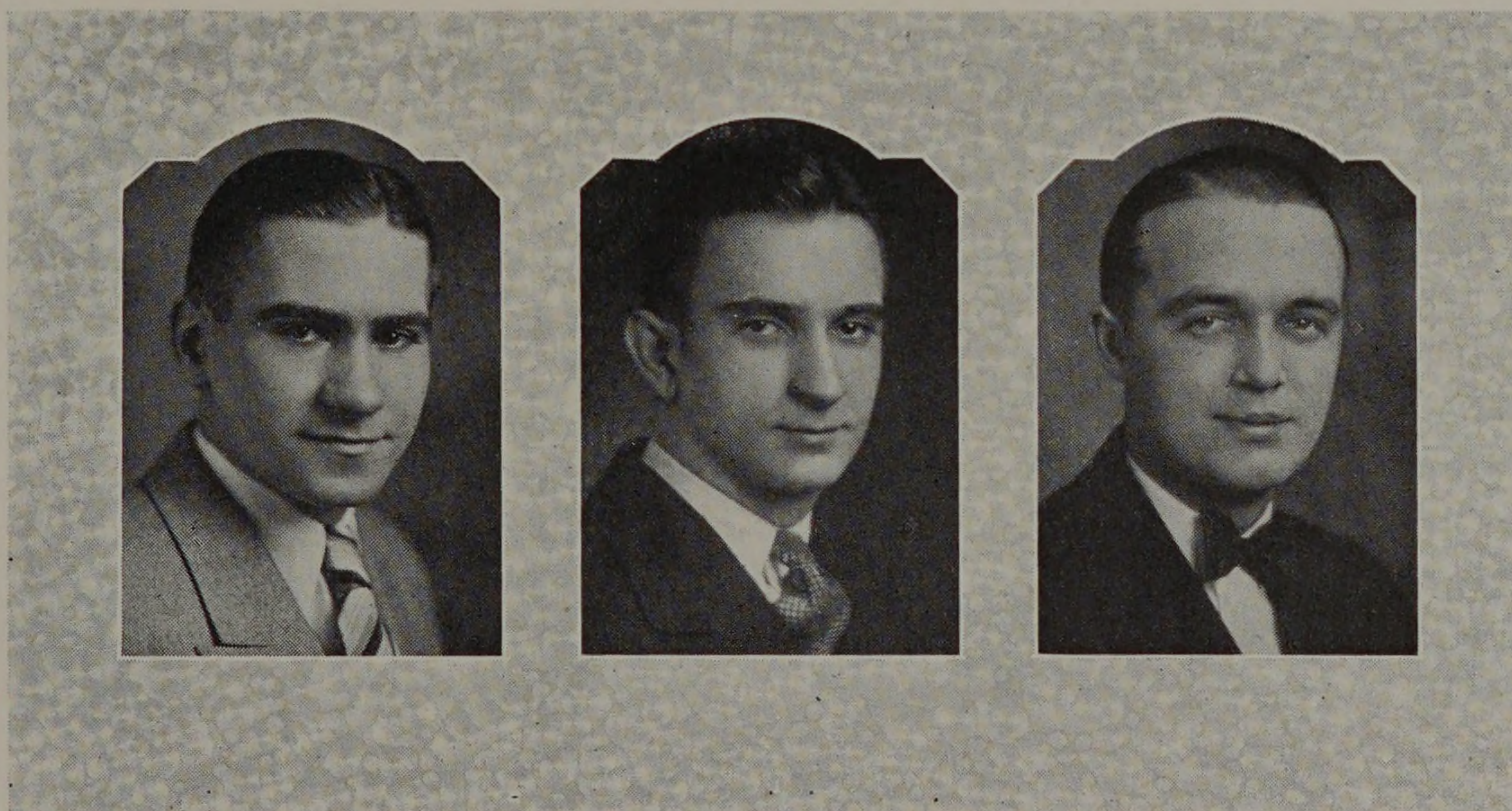
