

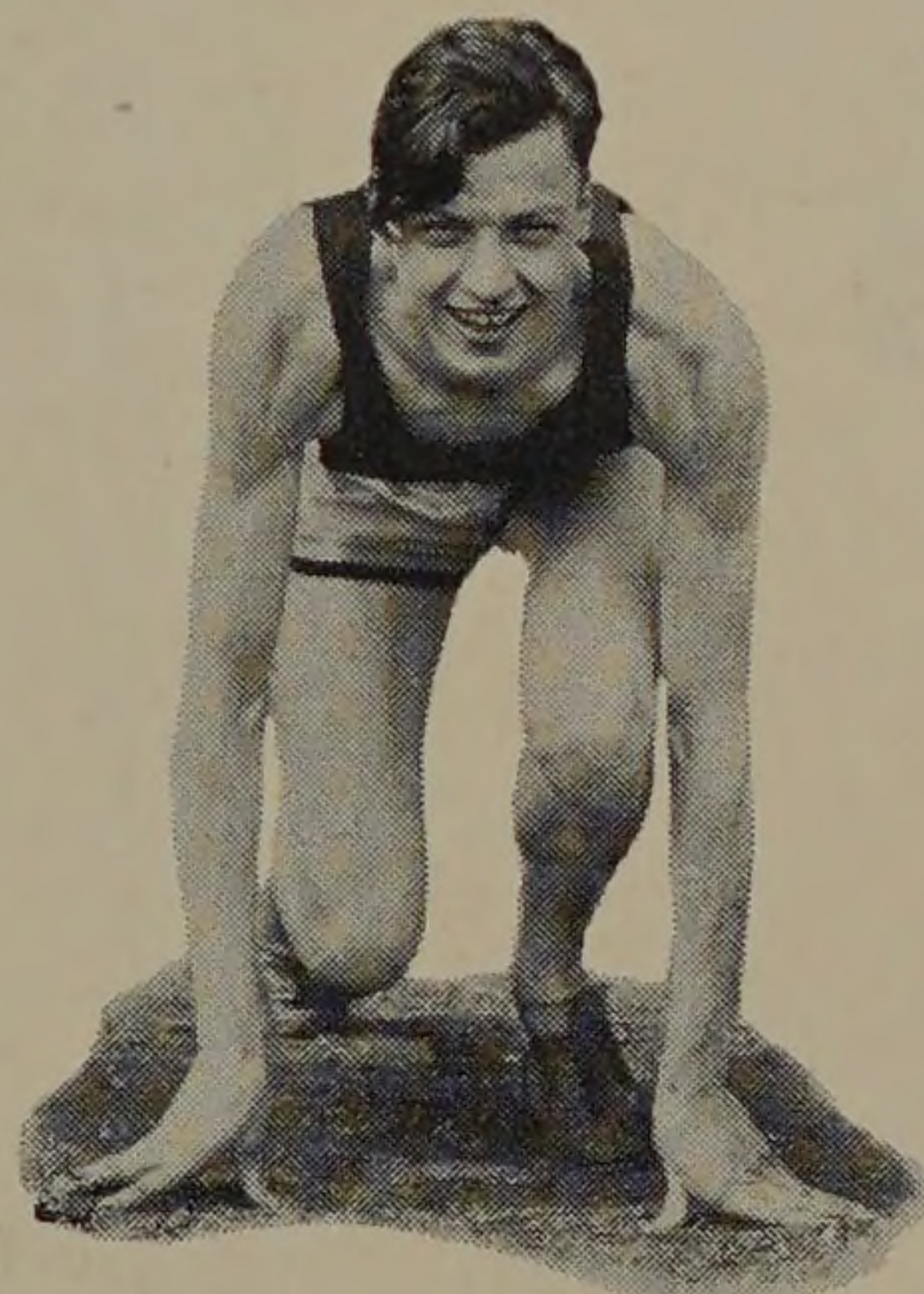
ARMOUR AT LAKE FOREST
