The next day, at Watertown, the Techites took another game from the home team by a score of five to two. Stehno pitched a very good game with an unusual amount of support. A triple play was recorded. With men on first and second, Reichle speared a liner apparently bounded for center field, tossed it to Rossetti for out number two, who threw to Robin for the third out. Armour was out-hit nine to eight.

The alumni came down to Ogden Field only to bow to the Freshman whiz, Stehno. He allowed seven hits and two runs, while the undergrads collected twelve hits and six runs. Another Freshman, Jervis, also contributed to the downfall of the Alumni by collecting four hits during the pastime.
