On March 4, 1907, Sphinx, honorary literary society, was founded. The coming of Sphinx to the Armour campus marked the installation of the second society in the honorary group at Armour. The executive staff members of the Fulcrum and the Integral formed a group organization which soon afterwards came to be known as Sphinx.

The society was formed for the purpose of fostering and promoting the publication work at Armour and to serve as an honor society for services rendered to the Institute through its publications.
