The Honor "A" Society was founded in the spring of 1914, and is one of the oldest existing organizations at Armour Institute. Originally it was organized as the governing body of athletics at Armour; in 1923 it was supplanted by the Armour Tech Athletic Association in that capacity, and now exists as a society to promote athletics and to bind the athletes, coaches, students, and alumni more closely together.
