score showed a 35 to 21 victory for Tech.


The first defeat was suffered at the hands of North Central at the Naperville school, the hard-fought contest ending in a 27 to 22 score. Although trailing by only one point at the end of the half, Tech was left behind during the second half. Two days later, on December 17, the Armour basketeers overwhelmed Crane College, 38 to 23. Tech took the lead early in the game, and was never headed, each member of the first team contributing at least four points with all the players participating.

Captain Rossing tossed four baskets and a free throw, Ilg sank four field goals, and Set-

terberg and Christoph added six points each. Captain Maloskie and Kraus starred for Crane, each scoring six points.

In the roughest game of the season, De Kalb defeated Armour after two overtimes had been played. Eleven personal fouls were called on each team, and more should have been. Armour was behind until the last few seconds of play, when Setterberg tied the score with a long shot. Each team scored a basket in the first overtime, but De Kalb scored two baskets to Tech's free throw in the second overtime, winning the game, 30 to 27.
