

Frateschi and Roberts threw the sixteen pound ball farther than the opponents. Then Roberts repeated the good work assisted by Manly when they took first and second place in the discus throw. In the last event, the javelin throw, the Cordes brothers with Ray Pflum's assistance won a second, a third, and a fourth, respectively.

Captain-elect Nelson was the season's leading scorer with Roberts running a close second and Capt. Sademan a close third.


