In 1909 the leaders of architecture at the University of Illinois organized a group called the Scarab fraternity. It had no intention of becoming a national organization when founded. An archiectural fraternity was organized at Armour in 1900. It was known as Alpha Delta Tau. This organization continued until 1915, when it was admitted, after petitioning, as Edfou Temple of Scarab Fraternity. There are now thirteen temples in the nation-wide organization.
