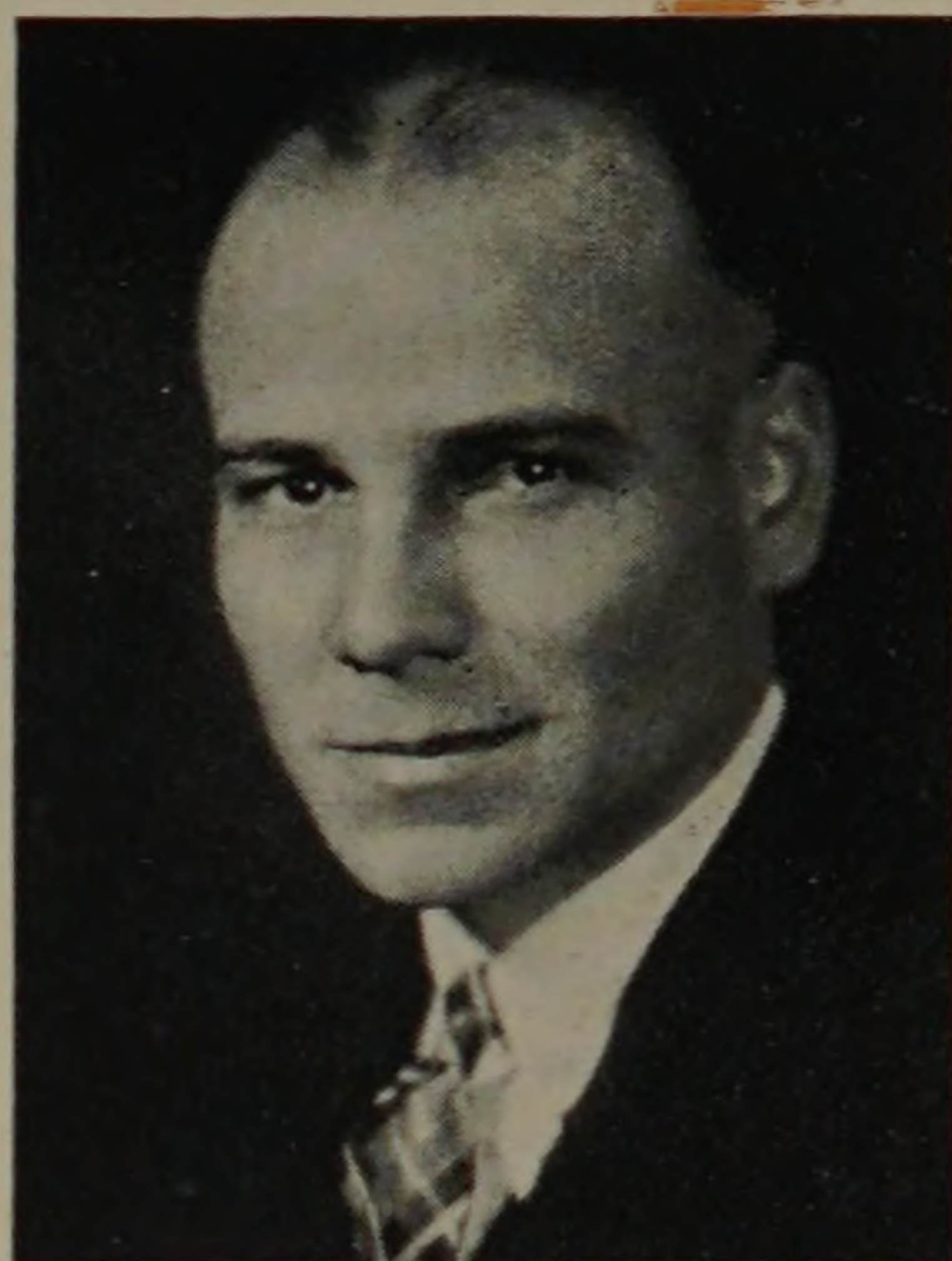

A record of eleven wins and five losses, with one tie, shows very well the efforts of the 1934 baseball squad under the able tutelage of Coach Krafft. With ten lettermen returning last spring and plenty of reserve material turning out, the mentor had every reason to expect a winning combination for his tenth season at Armour, and he was not disappointed.

Besides getting credit for seven wins out of eight chances as a pitcher, "Lefty" Mayer excelled as a hitter with a .359 batting average, though another good pitcher, Morelli, had the high .381. Captain Omiecinski, a very steady playing shortstop, turned in a .329 average, while his cousin, Captain-elect Tad, batted .307.
