Chi Epsilon, national honorary civil engineering fraternity, was founded at the University of Illinois in 1922 by outstanding student members of the department of civil engineering. In the following year a petition for a chapter of Chi Epsilon at Armour was presented to the officers of the fraternity. The petition was accepted by the fraternity, and the Armour chapter of Chi Epsilon was initiated on March 9, 1923.

Following years saw greater expansion of the fraternity with the result that today there are fifteen active chapters at leading engineering schools throughout the country and a membership of more than two thousand. Recognizing the fact that chapters many miles apart would have difficulty in functioning as one, the supreme council inaugurated the "Transit" as a semi-annual publication. Chapter news and articles of general or engineering interest are found in the magazine, the composition of which is the responsibility of the individual chapter representatives under the direction of the "Transit" editor.
