Alpha Sigma Phi was founded at Yale College on December 6, 1845, as a sophomore society. In 1850 Beta chapter was initiated as a sophomore society at Harvard. Other chapters were initiated, but it was not until 1907 that the national organization was perfected and a new period of expansion begun. At present there are thirty-seven active chapters throughout the country. There are several chapter alumni associations, but the main alumni organization is by means of councils which exist at all of the large cities. Alpha Sigma Phi has many prominent members among her alumni in this country and abroad.
