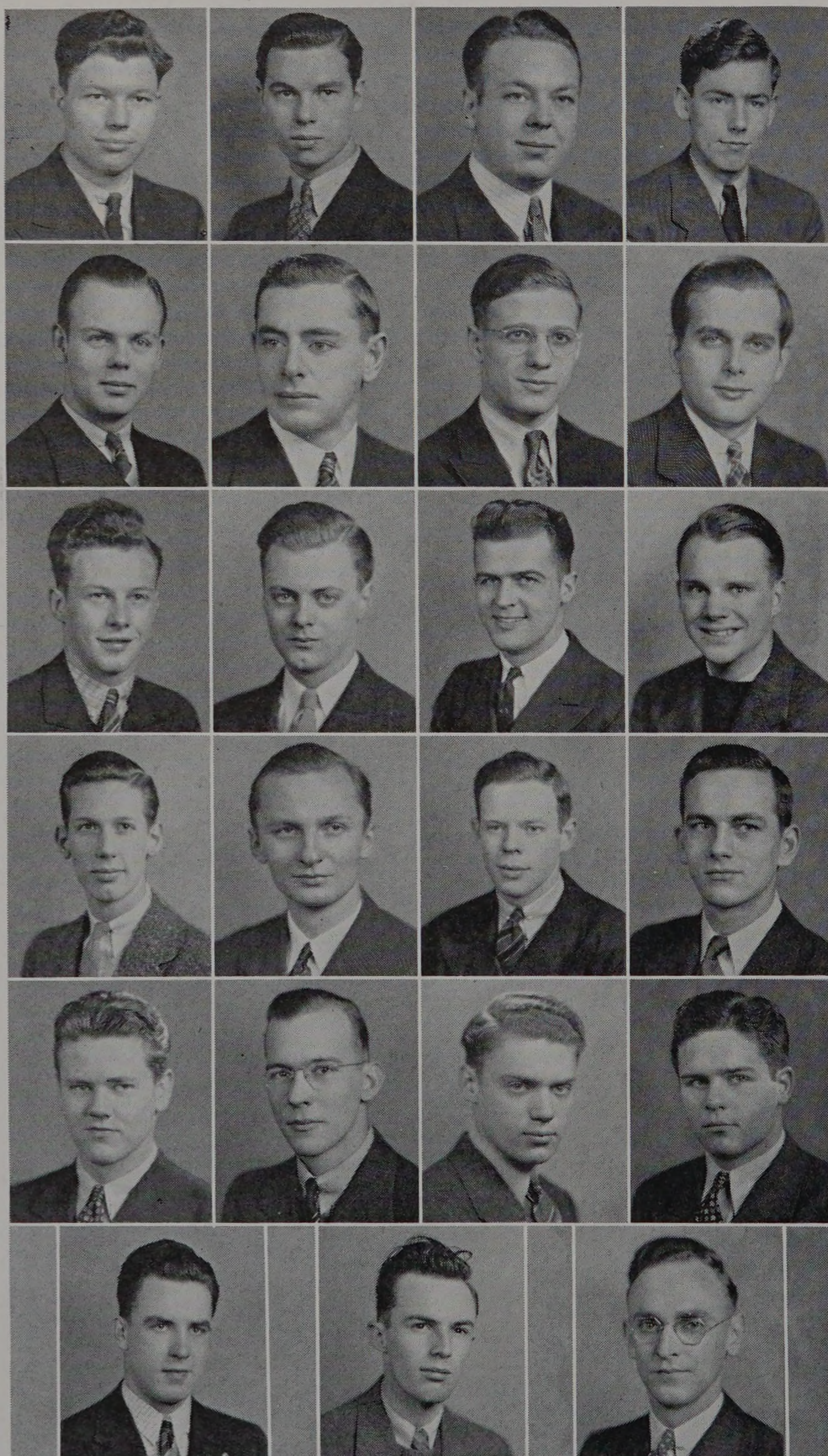

In 1938 a group of Armour students representing the social fraternities on the campus conceived the idea of forming an interfraternity society. After a year's trial the officers of the Institute extended permission to form an official interfraternity society, so on January 18, 1939, Beta Omega Nu was granted a charter as a duly recognized organization.
