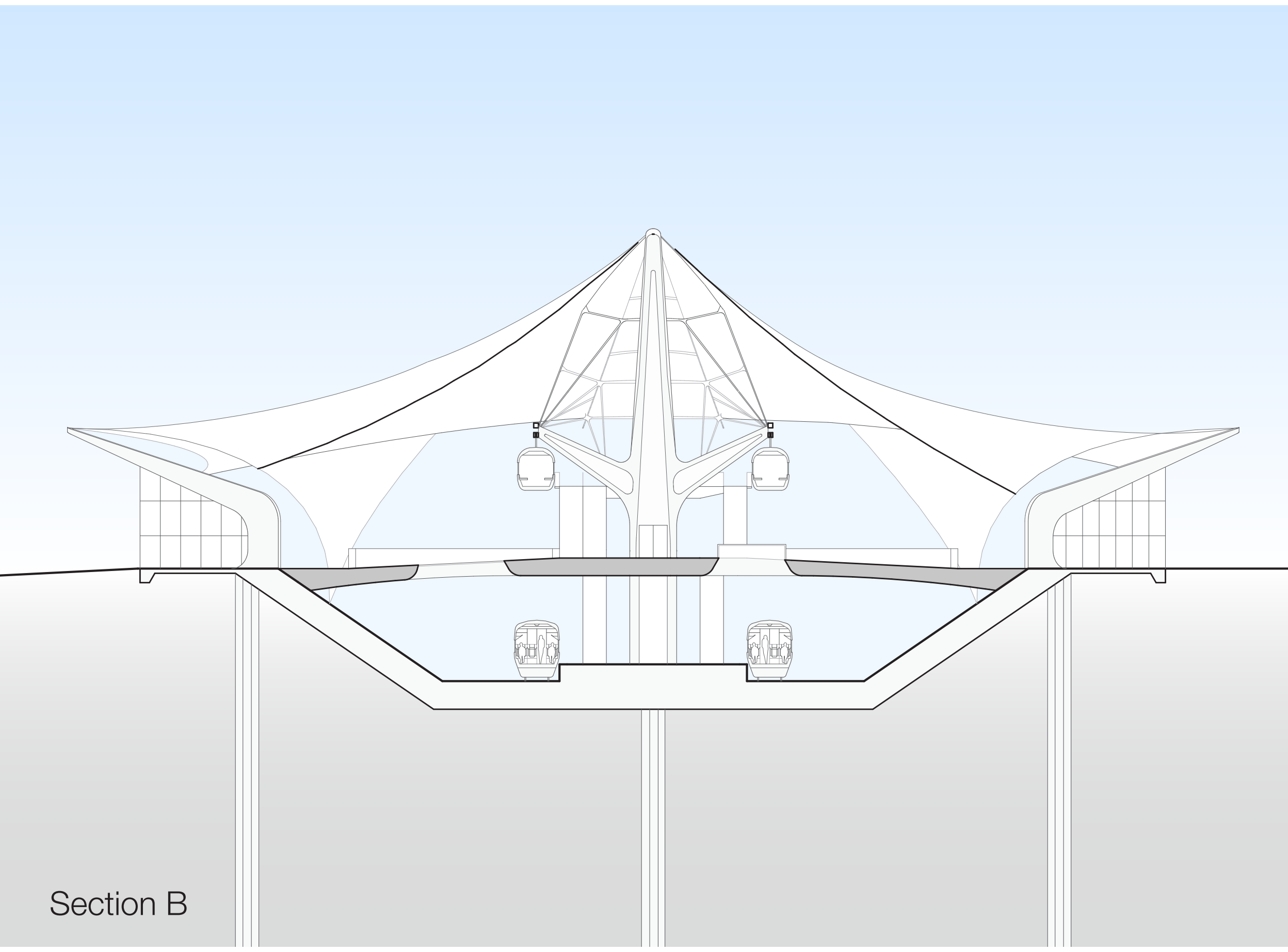
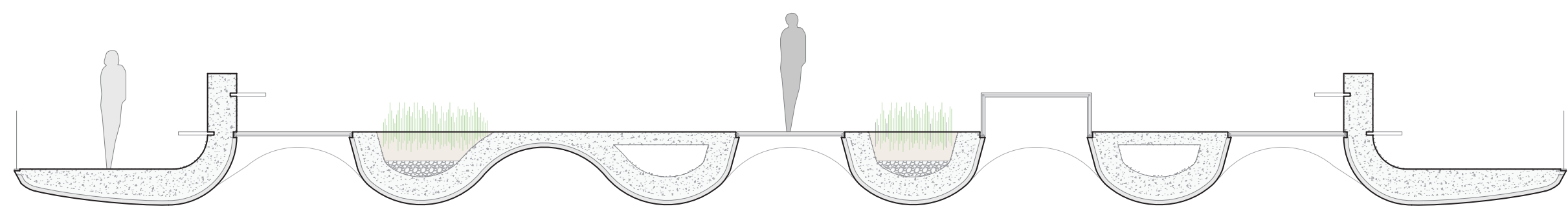
North Carolina State University is one of the leading land grant institutions and public research universities in the country. However, its rapidly growing **SIZE** and required **travel** distance in-between campuses necessitate drastically improved transit connections. Current plans are in place for the construction of a rapid transit corridor through campus along with commuter and light rail transit. The Master's Project will focus on the main multimodal center for this transportation network, the **North Carolina State University Rapid Transit Center...**

The NC State Rapid Transit Center **bridges** the past to the future by **connecting** historic rail lines that preceded the University with a new suspended monorail. The station **stretches** over the dividing tracks, **linking** the University's sprawling campuses and the surrounding region with commuter rail, monorail, buses, bicycles, and enhanced pedestrian access.
