Previous IPRO created ResearchWeb, a Web site that connects undergraduates with IIT research opportunities.

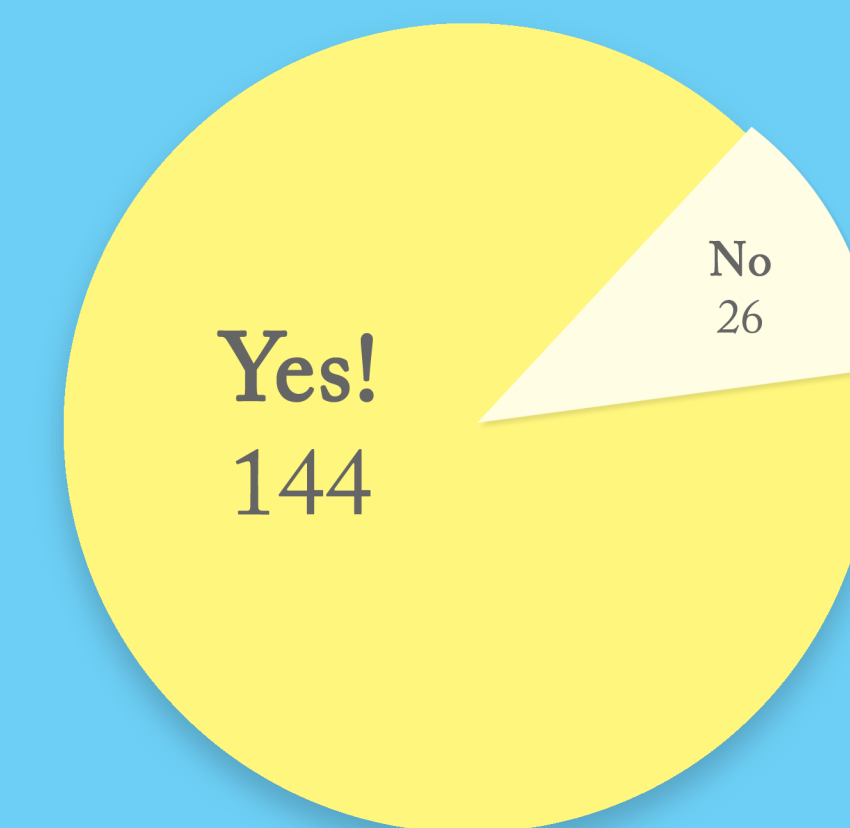

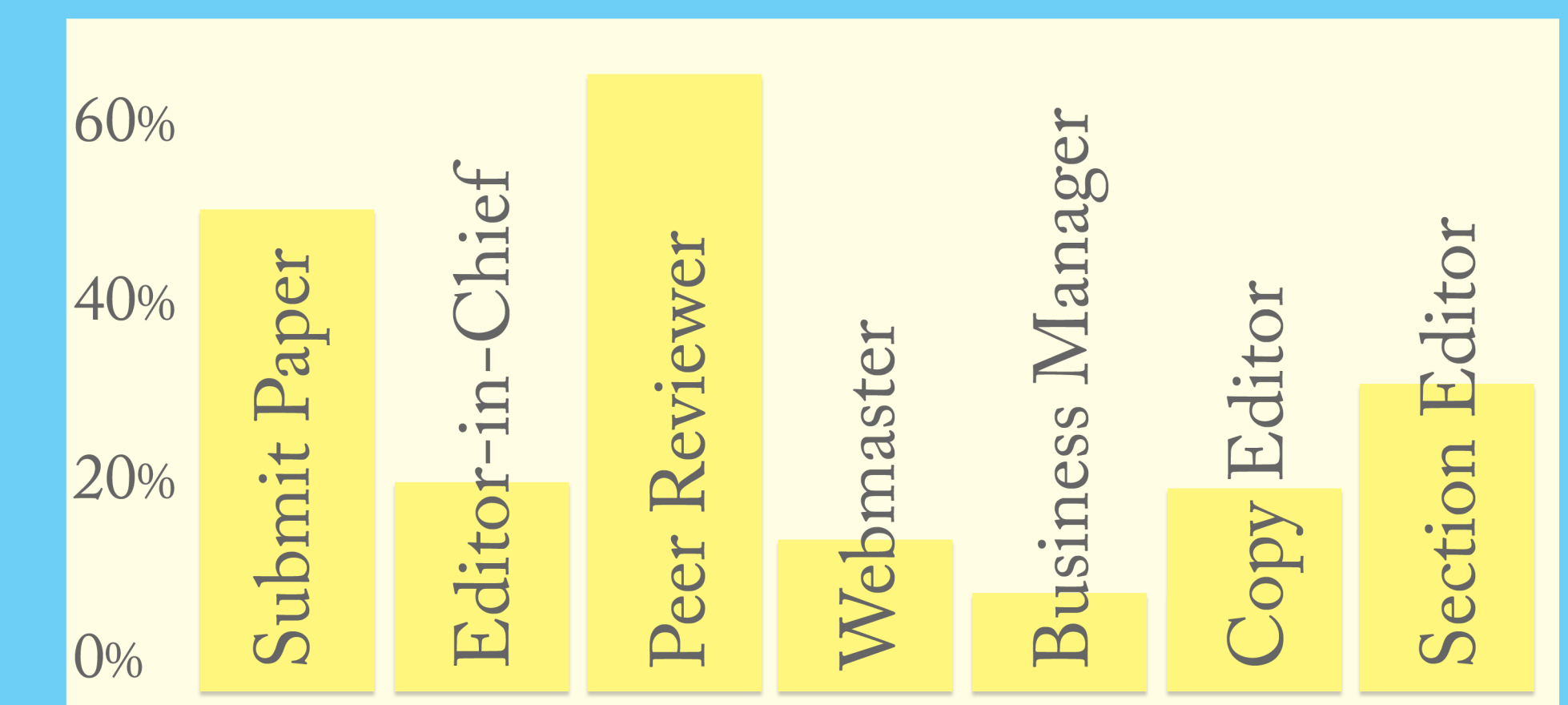

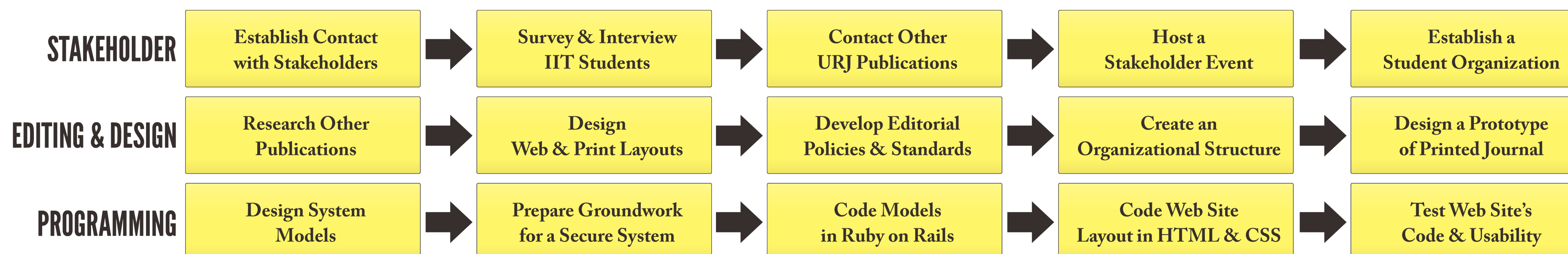
Would you be interested in reading URJiit?
