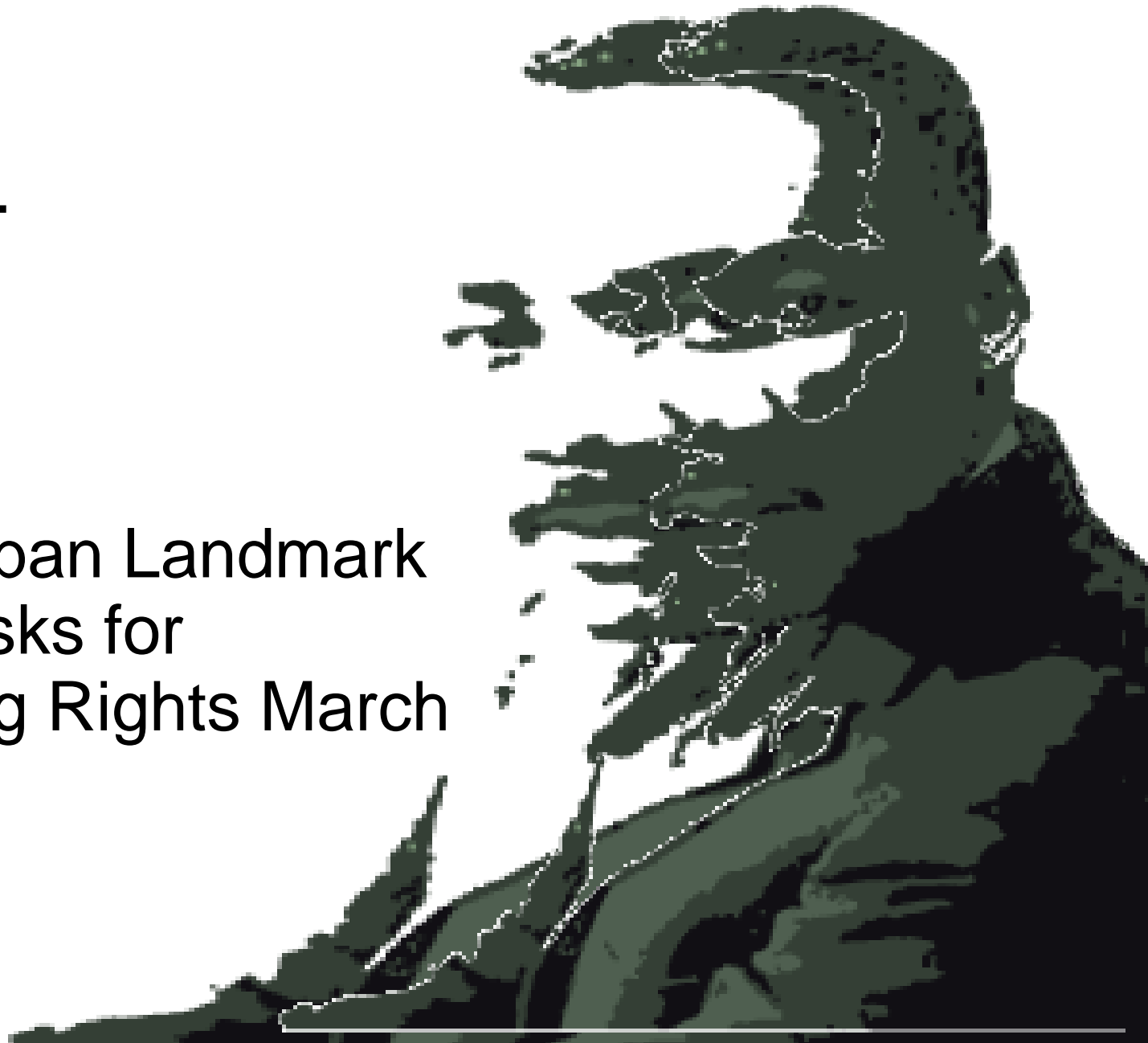


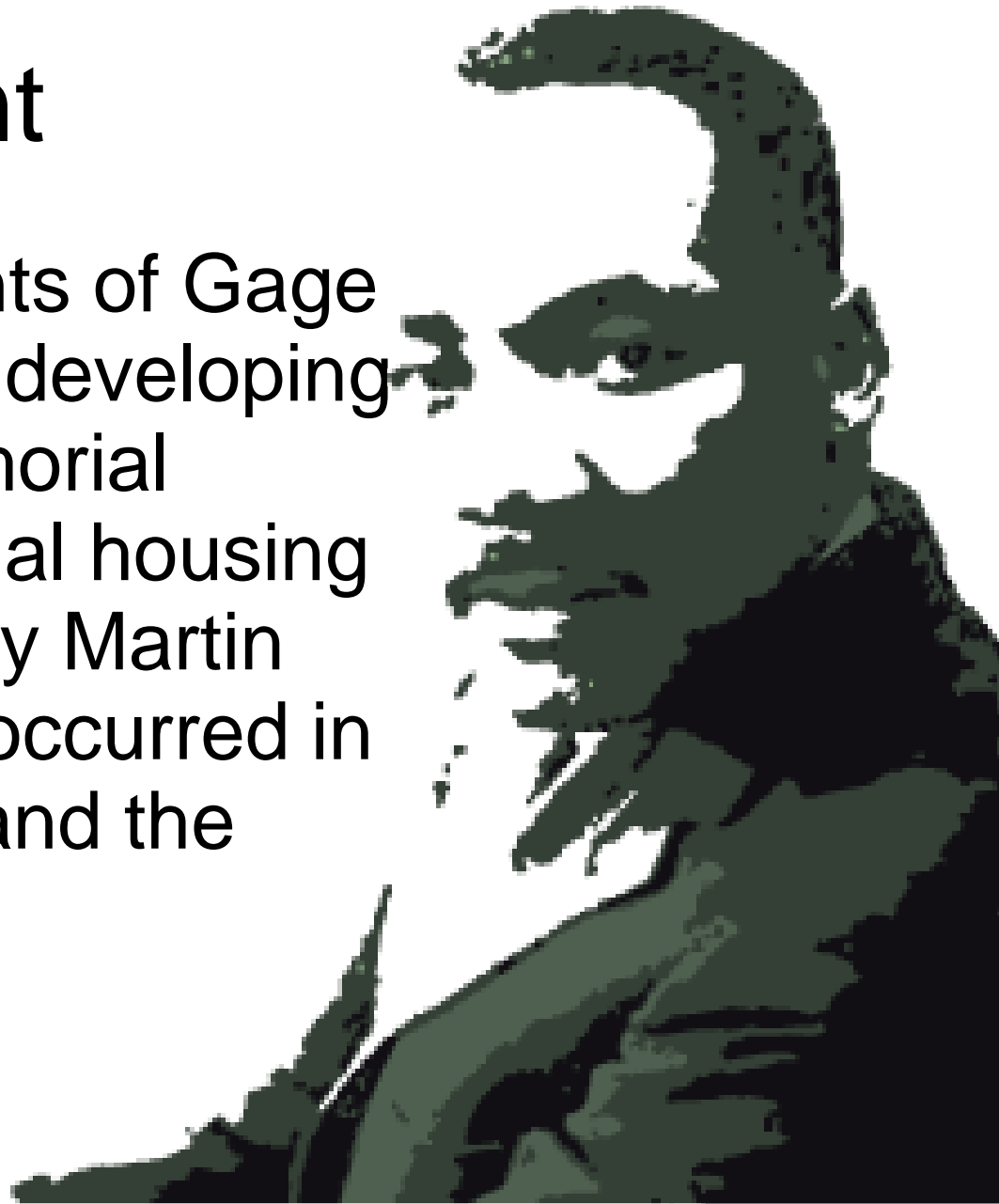

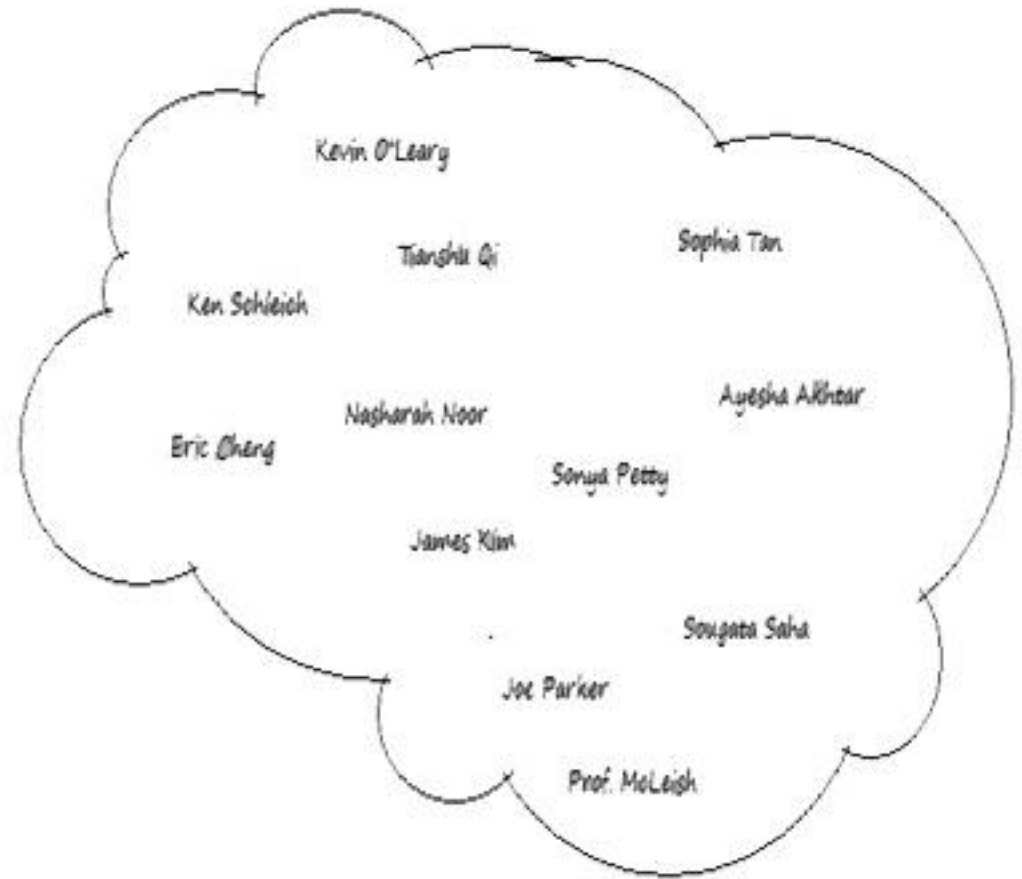
Vision Statement

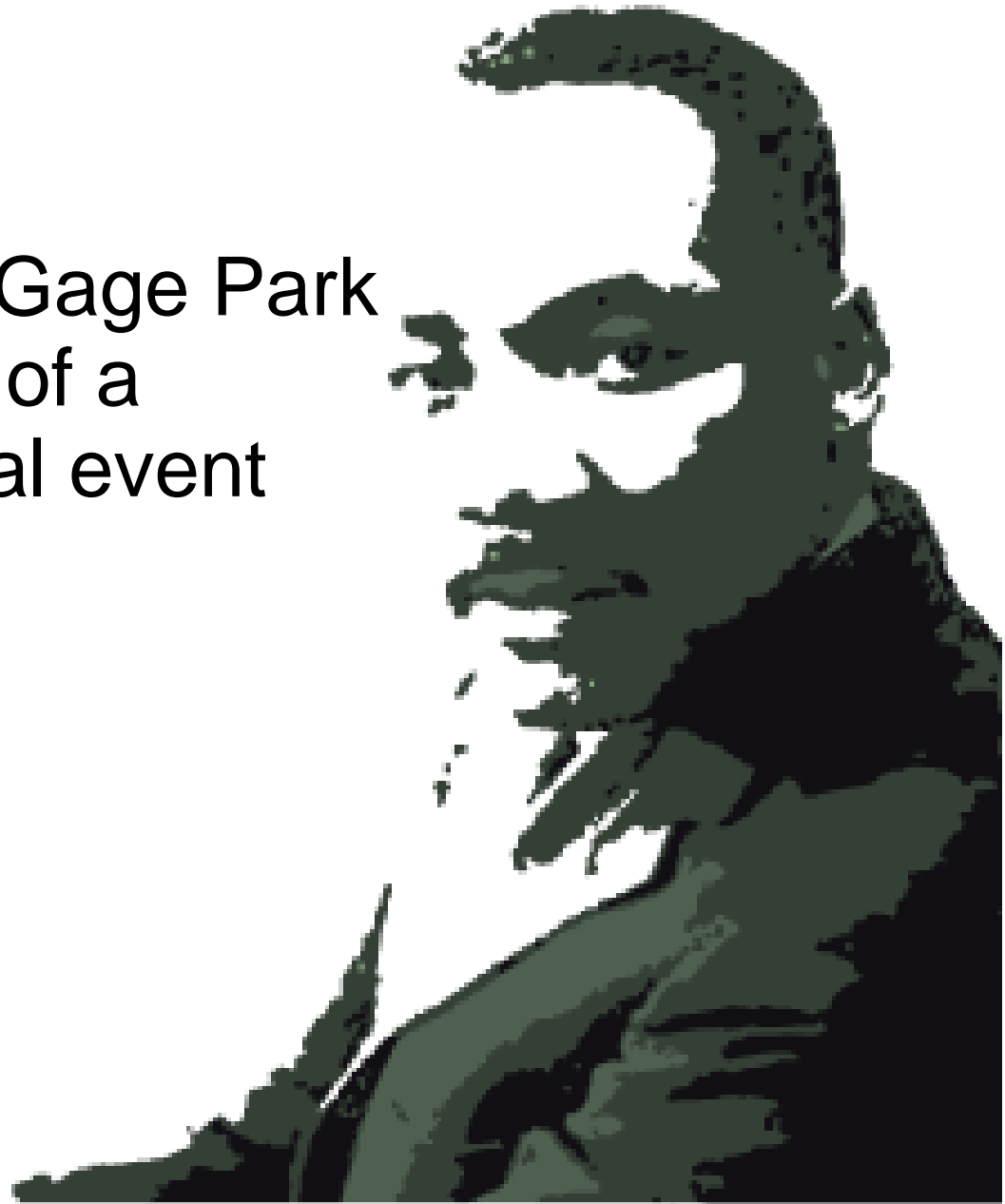
Team Organization

To help the students of Gage Park H.S. bring their vision of a memorial to a historical event into existence.



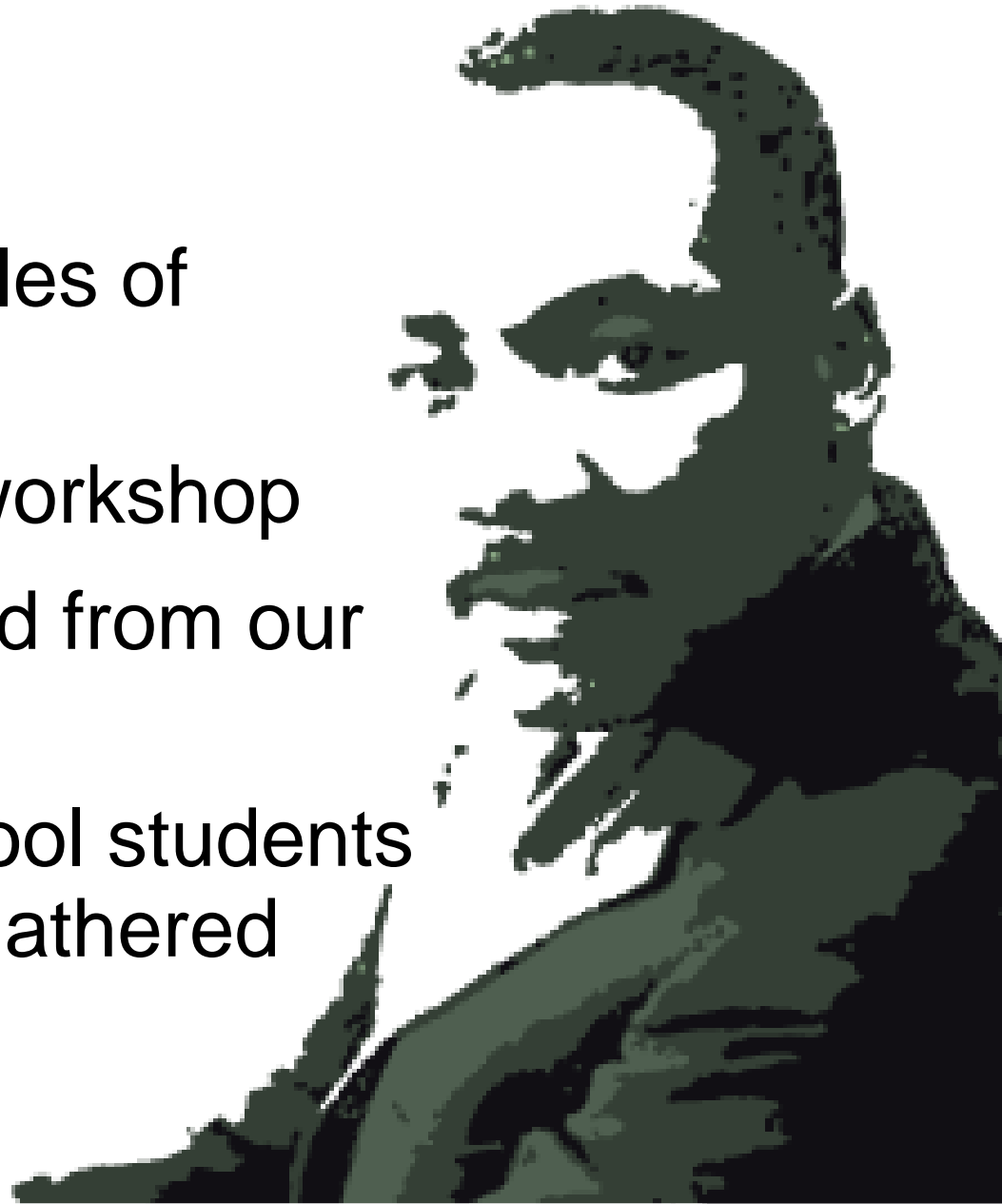
Process

Gather existing examples of precedents

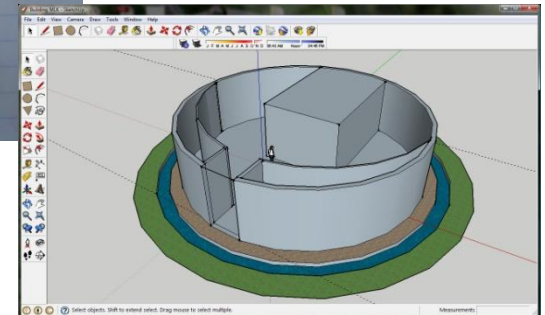
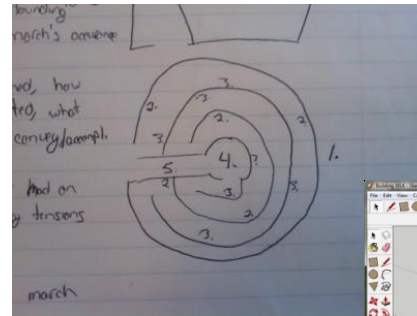
Have an introductory workshop

Return to the high school students with nurtured ideas gathered during the workshop

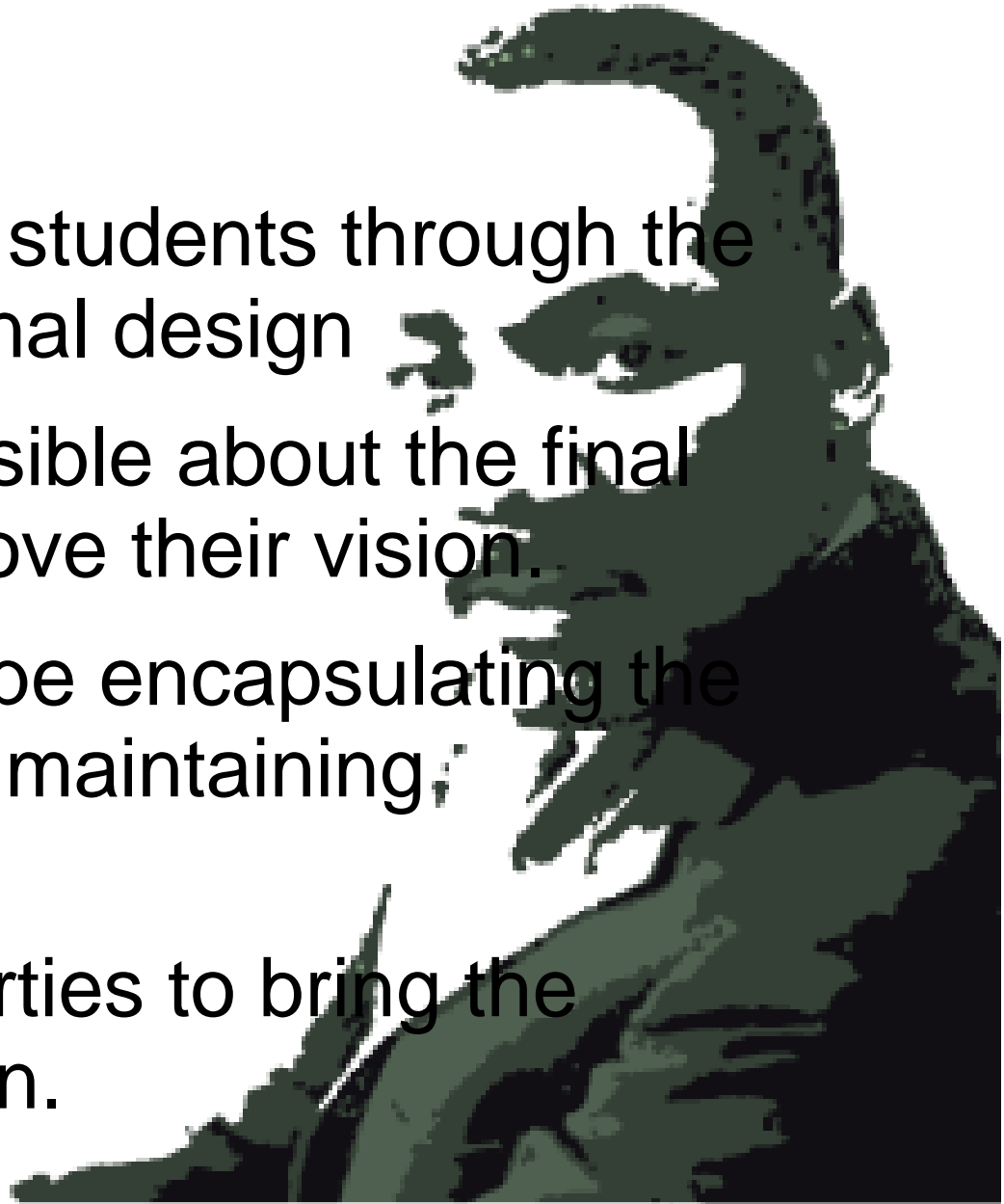

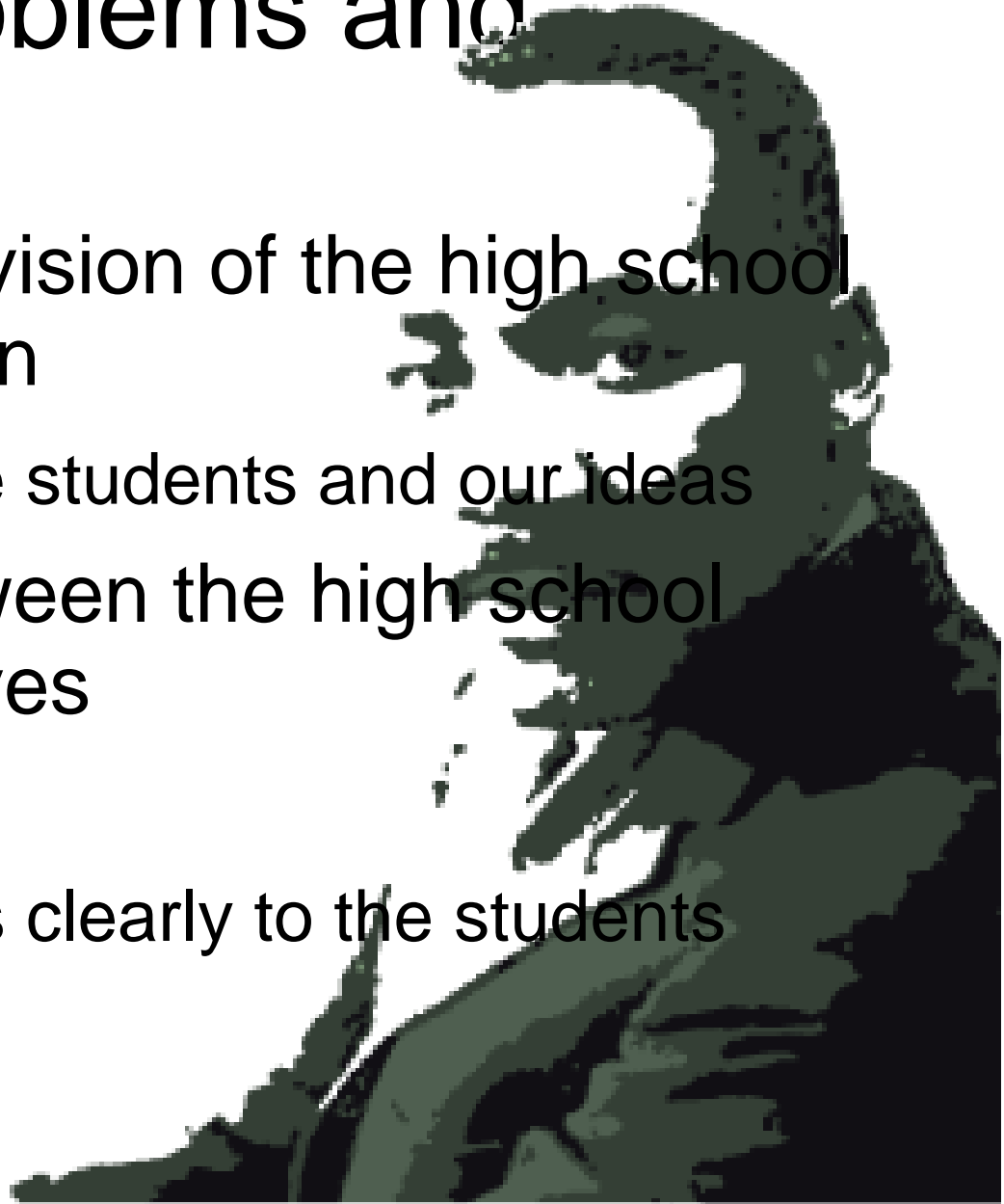
Moving Forward
