

- Write an article on PBC for publication






 Definition: The spoken narrative of past events of one's own experiences






Pilgrim Baptist Church

 Located on Corner of 33rd and Indiana

- Originally a JewishSynagogue
- Awarded LandmarkStatus in 1981
- Culture of the PBC has changed drastically over the past 60-70 years






Timeline of Events

- 1890 Louis Sullivan designed the Kehilath Anshe Ma'Ariv Synagogue
- □1915 Deacon J.A. Finney held the first prayer meeting group of the future PBC
- 1922 PBC began services in its present location
- 1932 Thomas A. Dorsey became choir director at PBC and founded the gospel choir
- Description 2001 PBC named 1 of 10 sacred places in U.S. to be saved and Rev. Hycel Taylor became senior pastor

We achieved our objectives by producing a video, brochure, website, and annotated resource material.


The relationship between IIT and the surrounding community was strengthened through this IPRO.


