**There is too much unreliable information out there about global warming and credibility is low.**

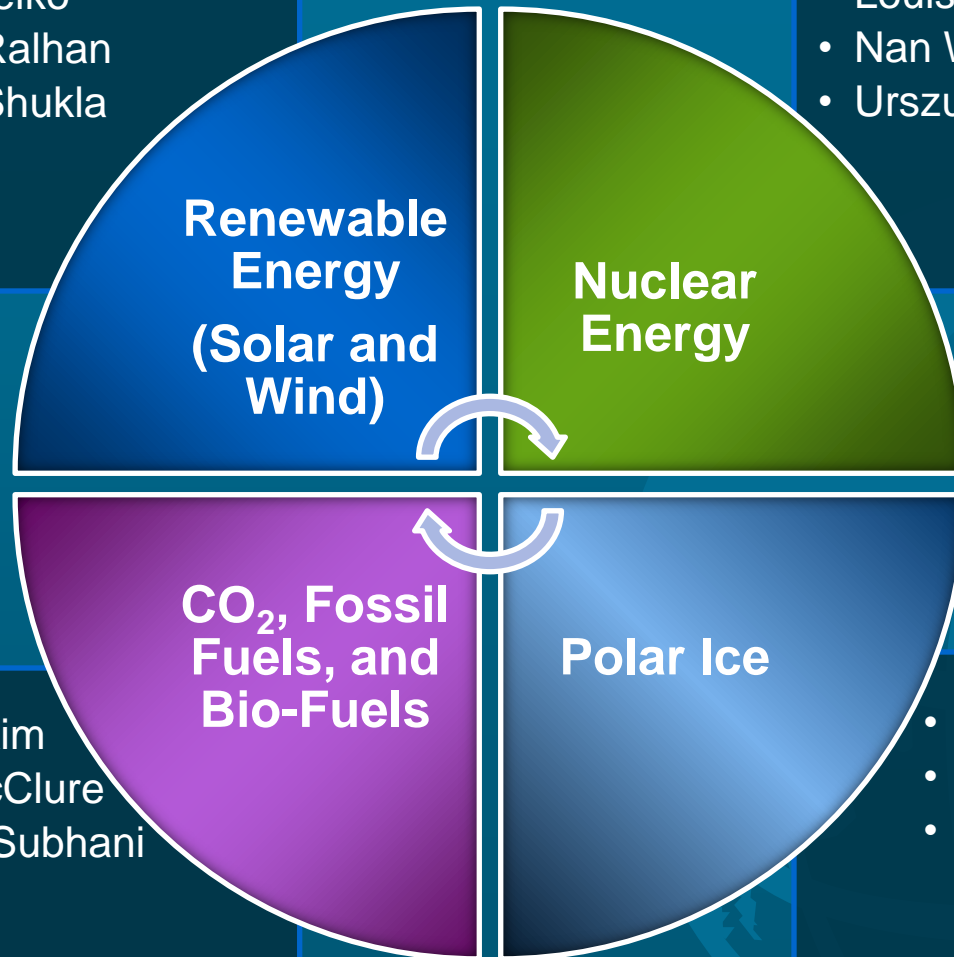
**Not enough knowledge and awareness exists about the topic of global warming.**
