



- ◆ Make Site Useable by future IPRO groups as a reporting mechanism.





- Flash Movie depicting installation and set up process






Interview with Dempsey J. Travis:

- an entrepreneur, historian, and self-made multi-millionaire
- coordinator of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr's first civil rights march in Chicago in 1960
- he was the president of the NAACP Chicago from 1959 to 1960
- served in the United States Army for four years


- Interviewed IIT alumnae on how they feel about the changes that has occurred in the Bronzeville area and their reaction towards the change.



Effects of IPRO 332 on my Educational Experience


- Able to learn more about IIT and its symbiotic relationship with the surrounding community.




Future efforts
