### **Traditional Website**


 Requires a developer

# **Dynamic Administration**

- Non-technical authors can create and edit new hierarchies
- Content can be created as text or HTML using a already familiar tools such as notepad or Microsoft Word
- Updates and additions are performed via admin webpages and stored in a database

# **Database Design**

To accommodate dynamic hierarchies and content, the database was organized in this manner



### **Database Design**

- Items represent hierarchy, and therefore can link to other items, representing a folder tree structure similar to windows.
- Content is linked to items, and are analogous to files in a folder.
