Fab Lab Membership Use

- Fab Lab members will require an MSI membership and will pay a quarterly maintenance fee
- A training and certification course will be be required prior to Fab Lab use
- Members can reserve one of 5 stations within the Fab Lab
- Stations must be reserved prior to Fab lab visit and will be available for \$30 per 60 min block
- Fabrication materials will be purchased through and provided by Fab Lab staff

Fab Lab Exhibit

- A new Fab Lab exhibit will wrap around the exterior wall of the Fab Lab
- Purpose of the Exhibit will be to spread awareness of the Fab Lab while attracting user interest.
- Timeline featuring the Fab Lab history, growth of the Fab Lab network, and possibilities for future applications
- Interactive kiosks showing virtual representation of Fab Lab where users can learn about the capabilities of each machine and create a virtual invention.
- Graphics around the wall detailing each Fab Lab station and the science behind it.
- Viewing portholes into the Fab Lab so that patrons can see the lab in use.
- Membership brochures will be available at the end of the exhibit along with a reference to the Fab Lab website.

Learning Labs

- Fab Lab learning labs will be an engaging experience that educates students about the history of the Fab Lab, capabilities of each Fab Lab station, and the step by step completion of a project selected by the group educator.

- Fab Lab learning lab sessions will accommodate groups of up to 20 students and will be conducted twice daily, 3-5 days a week
- Educators can choose from a variety of different projects, each with their own set of pre-visitation activities to be completed within the classroom.
