This Semester

Although we've developed and maintained a website to help students with their science fairs, we lacked the resources to provide direct one-on-one help. To make our previous work more impacting, we focused on writing a grant proposal to the NSF's Math and Science Partnership program.

Our Objectives

- Make final changes to the website so that it is more self-sustainable.
- Strengthen our relationship with existing CPS contacts and continue outreach to support our grant proposal.
- Write a grant proposal for an oncampus learning center for CPS students to visit and receive help on their science fairs from IIT faculty and students.

Team Organization

Two sub-teams:

- Website: Continue to make the website more consistent. Perform usability testing and gather data to support a need for an on-campus learning center
- Writing: Responsible for writing the majority of the grant proposal. Worked closely with other team members to get relevant information from CPS and university officials make a convincing argument for an on-campus learning center.
