



The Group Study Suite at Illinois Tech is a collaborative space which has been consistently evolving to match the needs of its dynamic on-campus community.



Group Study @Galvin

- Increasing demand led to the creation of Group Study Space(GSS) to support collaborative study at Illinois Tech's Galvin Library in August 2008.
- It has evolved into functions not considered at its inception.
- GSS in its current form is a good example of how a space conceived as a single use area, could evolve into a multifunctional space based on needs of the customer.

GroupStudy@Galvin

- Numerous studies on collaborative study space in academic libraries have led to the following conclusions:
 - Groups meet in a campus library because the space is available for longer hours.
 - Library study allows them extended work sessions in comfortable surroundings conveniently placed to other academic buildings.
 - Such spaces offer electrical power, Wi-Fi, reserve materials (especially textbooks), and other desirable resources.

GroupStudy@Galvin

- Reception area in GSS has also evolved into a space for hanging out, impromptu meetings, a lunch area and desks for individual study.
- GSS has become a convenient and functional place for holding IIT based events organized by faculty, students and staff.
- In-house study demonstrated that the students using the GSS had the highest mean GPA among students using the library.


- Over the years, the Group Study Area at Galvin Library has hosted numerous events:

- The Exploration Space consists of:
 - Two 3D printers

 - Button maker
 - Label maker
 - Low-tech fun: coloring, origami, kinetic sand




ExplorationSpace@Galvin

- Summer programs and high-school interns also have used our Exploration Space.



(Room G in Transition)




